
INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS FOR GEAR SHAFT SEAL



- 1. Remove lower axle housing bolt and nut for clearance and remove gear shaft lock plate and bolt.
- 2. Clean shaft ends and flat place on transmission with a good cleaner. Preferrably Aerosol Degreaser. CAUTION: Do not disturb gear shafts or they will slip out of place.
- 3. Apply a small amount of SILICONE RTV gasket maker on one side of lock plate and stick in place between gear shafts.
- 4. Place 3/8" bolt in seal and fit in place with beveled side up, start bolt, but do not tighten. This is to be sure of correct way to install.
- 5. Remove seal, coat inside and around edges of seal and 3/8" bolt with silicone and re-install. Be sure seal goes completely over lock plate before tightening bolt.
- 6. Replace bolt in drive shaft housing. Allow sealer to dry and drive your Model A leak free.

CAUTION: A Very early reverse idler shaft may extend much more than 1/4" from transmission. With lock plate in place use angle grinder or cut off tool to remove excess length.
